The college was established in the year 1993 with Degree Course in pharmacy (B. Pharm. Intake-60); and M. Pharm. course in Pharmaceutical Chemistry (Intake -18) was introduced in 2004-05, and M. Pharm. course in Pharmaceutics (Intake-10), M. Pharm. course in Pharmacology (Intake-10) in 2007-08. The college has been approved as Research center for Ph. D. in Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences by Savitribai Phule Pune University since academic year 2008-09. The college has introduced a Pharm course in 2019-20 (60 intakes).

The college has the approval of various governing bodies like All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) New Delhi, Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) New Delhi, and Government of Maharashtra and is permanently affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University. The college has been recognized under 2(f) & 12 (B) by UGC since 2012. The college has been accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade in cycle-2 on 28/02/2022. It received 'Best College Award' from Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune on 10th Feb 2016.

Yoga Activity (23/09/2023)

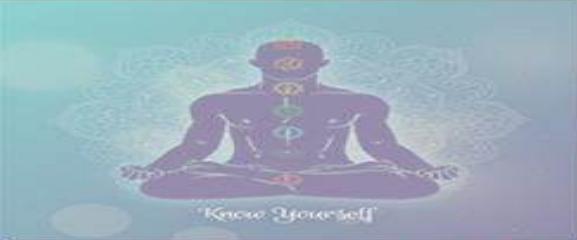

(08/12/2023)**

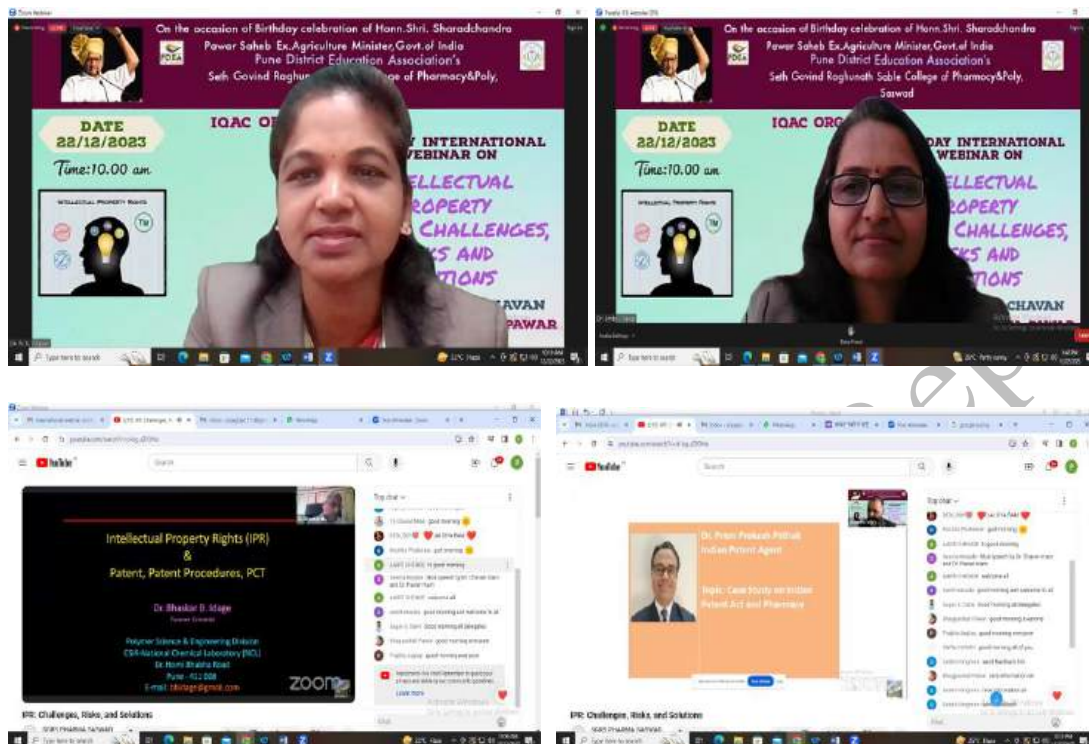

by Mrs. Sunita Bathe. The program was coordinated by Ms. Sayali Chavan and Mrs. Sunita Bathe.

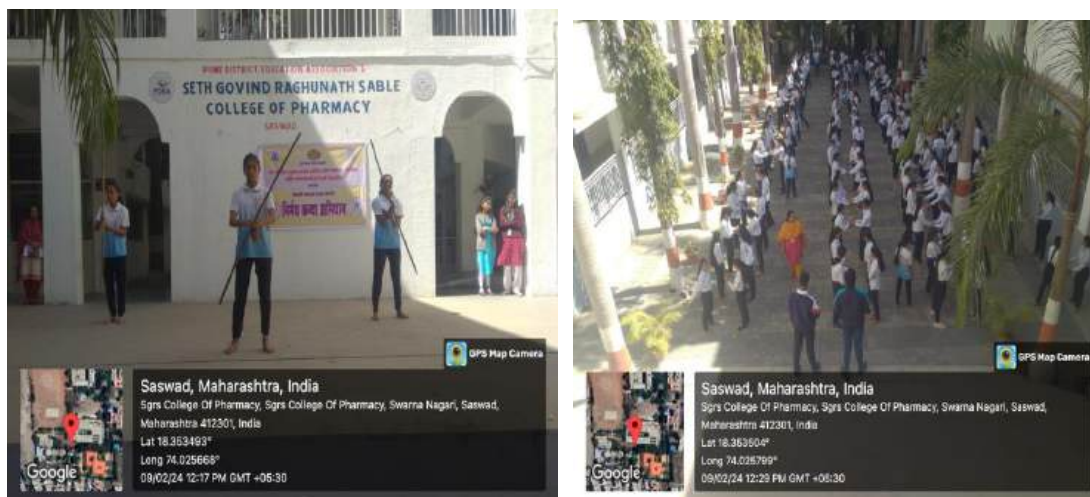


❖ Nirbhaya Kanya Abhiyaan (09/02/2024)

❖ Career Opportunities in Market research (16/03/2024)

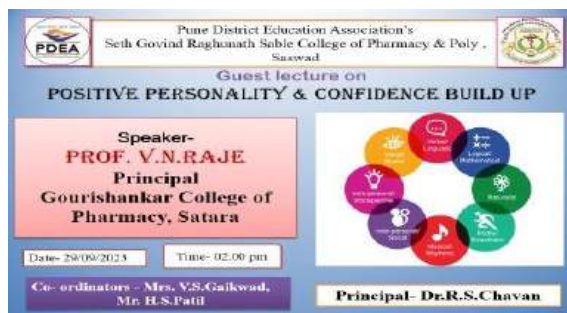

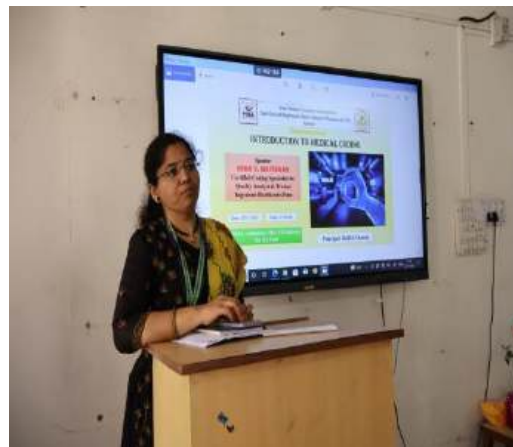

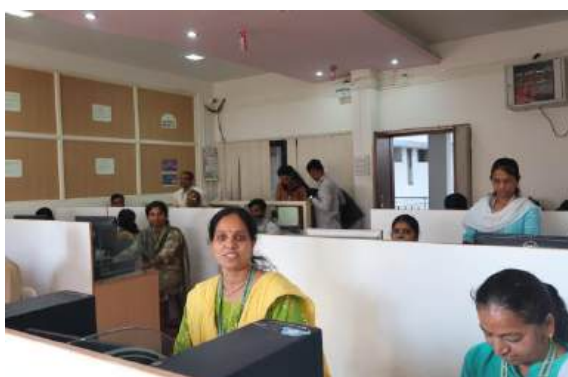
❖ Seminar on “Preclinical experimentation Designing to Report writing”(04/09/2023)

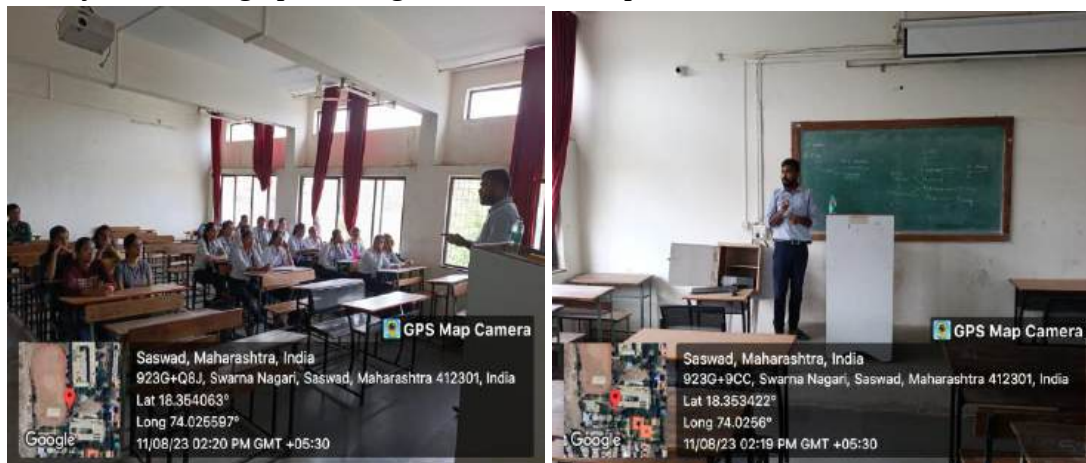

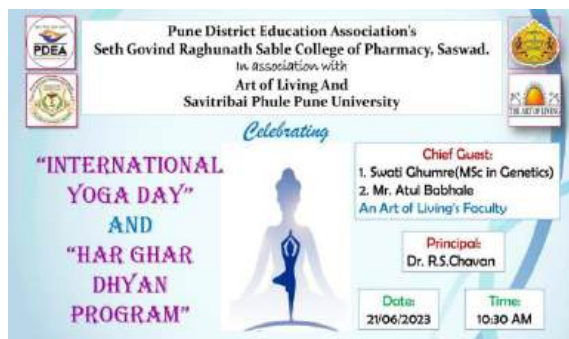
❖ Reading day (19/06/2023)

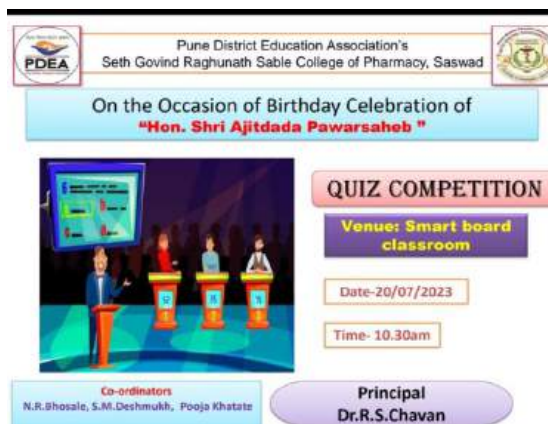
❖ International Yoga Day (21/06/2023)
