D. in Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences by Savitribai Phule Pune University since academic year 2008-09. The college has introduced a D.Pharm course in 2019-20 (60 intakes). M. Pharm in Pharmacognosy is introduced in the academic year 2024-25.

The college has the approval of various governing bodies Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) New Delhi, Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, Mumbai and Government of Maharashtra and is permanently affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. ❖ Guest Lecture on "Career Opportunities in Clinical Research" (20/03/2025)




❖ Reels Making Competition for Disease Awareness (25/07/2024)

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

❖ Nirmalya Collection Campaign (18/09/2024)

Project Completed:

During the camp, various Shramdan projects were undertaken and successfully completed in the village. The completed projects include:

Day 1: 19th January 2025 – Bhaktanivas and Premises Cleanliness Drive

The camp commenced with a cleanliness drive at Bhaktanivas and its surrounding premises, where NSS volunteers actively participated in cleaning the area. As Bhaktanivas served as the accommodation for the NSS camp, this initiative ensured a clean and hygienic environment for the volunteers while also promoting the importance of cleanliness.

Day 2: 20th January 2025 – Shrinath Mhaskoba Temple Cleanliness Drive

On the second day, volunteers undertook the cleaning of the historic Shrinath Mhaskoba Temple and its surrounding areas. The activity was followed by an awareness session on self-employment and agribusiness opportunities, where experts guided rural youth on sustainable livelihood practices.

camp, which was conducted in association with the Primary Healthcare Center, Saswad, and Pariche. Medical professionals screened students for anemia and other health concerns, provided consultations, and recommended necessary dietary and medical interventions. The initiative aimed to raise awareness about proper nutrition and healthcare among rural students.

Day 7: 25th January 2025 – Concluding Ceremony & Cleanliness Drive

These activities were part of the NSS camp's objective to promote social awareness, health, and empowerment in the community, with a focus on women, children, and overall well-being.


Workshops and Discussion Sessions:


