Report on Industrial Visit

Place: Shalina Healthcare, Jejuri MIDC (Pune)

An industrial visit to Shalina Healthcare, Jejuri (Pune), was organized for M. Pharm students on 18 April 2026 at 2:00 pm. A total 24 students participated in the visit under the guidance of faculty members Dr. Prashant Khade and Ms. Shweta Gite. The visit aimed to provide advanced practical exposure to pharmaceutical manufacturing, quality systems, regulatory compliance, and industrial practices relevant to postgraduate pharmacy education.

Objectives of the Visit

- Understand large-scale pharmaceutical manufacturing processes.
- Study Quality Assurance (QA) and Quality Control (QC) systems in detail.
- Gain exposure to Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) and regulatory requirements.
- Bridge the gap between academic knowledge and industrial application.
- Explore career opportunities and industry expectations for M. Pharm graduates.

Shalina Healthcare is a reputed pharmaceutical company involved in the manufacturing and distribution of a wide range of medicinal products, especially in emerging markets. The company focuses on affordability, quality, and compliance with international regulatory standards.

Students observed advanced pharmaceutical manufacturing processes including:

- **Dispensing and Weighing:** Controlled handling of raw materials under regulated environmental conditions.
- **Granulation Techniques:** Both wet and dry granulation processes were explained.
- **Compression:** Tablet formation using high-speed compression machines.
- **Coating:** Film coating processes for controlled drug release and stability.
- **Packaging:** Automated blister and strip packaging systems ensuring product integrity.

The QA team explained documentation practices, validation processes, in-process checks, and deviation handling, while the QC lab demonstrated analytical techniques like HPLC, UV spectroscopy, dissolution testing, and stability studies, all under GMP and international standards with emphasis on data integrity. A technical session allowed M. Pharm students to interact with industry experts on career opportunities, regulatory roles, and process scale-up. Overall, the visit was highly beneficial, offering practical exposure to pharmaceutical industry practices and enhancing students' academic and professional growth.
