As a part of the Environmental Awareness Activities the Green Club organized an activity entitled **"Indian Native Tree Conservation Drive"** on 13/05/2026.

The activity was conducted with the following objectives:

- To create awareness regarding conservation of native Indian plant species.
- To promote environmental sustainability and ecological balance.
- To encourage students' active participation in environmental protection activities.
- To develop social responsibility and environmental ethics among students.
- To conserve indigenous biodiversity through plantation of native tree species.
- To motivate students towards long-term tree conservation and green initiatives.

To support environmental protection through future transplantation of developed seedlings during the rainy season. Under this initiative, **200 seeds** of Indian native tree species such as

- Arjun (*Terminalia arjuna*),
- Karanja (*Pongamia pinnata*),
- Badam (*Terminalia catappa*),
- Hirda (*Terminalia chebula*),
- Amla (*Phyllanthus emblica*)

and other indigenous plants were planted in grow bags.

Students were guided regarding proper seed sowing techniques, care of seedlings, and the importance of conserving native biodiversity. It was planned that after proper growth and development of the

seedlings, the plants will be transplanted at suitable locations during the rainy season to support environmental protection and tree conservation efforts in the surrounding region.

Principal Dr. Rajshree Chavan guided the students and appreciated the initiative undertaken by the institute for promoting environmental awareness and sustainable development. She emphasized the importance of preserving native tree species for maintaining ecological balance and encouraged students to actively participate in such conservation activities for the welfare of society and future generations.

Dr. Prashant Khade, Students Development Officer, explained the purpose and significance of organizing such environmental activity. He motivated students to contribute actively towards environmental conservation and highlighted the importance of protecting indigenous plant species for maintaining biodiversity and improving environmental health.
