The Green Club the College organized a **Summer Bird Care Initiative** on **21/04/2026 at 3:30 PM** in the college campus. The initiative was undertaken with the objective of creating awareness among students about the importance of protecting birds during the summer season and encouraging them to contribute towards biodiversity conservation through simple yet meaningful actions.

Prior to the activity, the Green Club appealed to all students to actively participate by bringing materials that could help provide food and water for birds. Students enthusiastically responded to the appeal and contributed various items, including earthen pots, coconut shells, bird feeders, and grains such as rice, wheat, bajra, and millets. Some students also showcased their creativity by preparing eco-friendly bird feeders using ice cream sticks, demonstrating that simple recyclable materials can be effectively utilized for environmental conservation.

During the activity, Green Club members, along with students from different classes, installed coconut shells, earthen pots, and bird feeders at suitable locations across the college campus, particularly under shaded trees and areas frequently visited by birds. Fresh drinking water and grains were placed in these containers to ensure easy access for birds during the peak summer months when natural food and water sources become scarce.

The initiative not only provided immediate relief to birds but also sensitized students towards the importance of wildlife conservation and ecological balance. Through active participation, students realized that environmental responsibility extends beyond plantation drives and cleanliness campaigns to include compassion and care for all living beings.
