7. Evaluation Methodology

A two-evaluator system was used for independent assessment. Each evaluator awarded a maximum of 10 marks for each of five criteria, giving 50 marks per evaluator. The final average was calculated as: $(\text{Evaluator 1 Total} + \text{Evaluator 2 Total}) \div 2$. Evaluator 2 marks were finalized as whole-number marks.

8. Participation and Processing

A total of 64 scientific articles were received/evaluated. The articles were assessed by two evaluators. A consolidated Sr. No.-wise average calculation sheet was prepared from the two evaluator sheets. The result process was extended because of the overwhelming response and the need to ensure fair evaluation.
